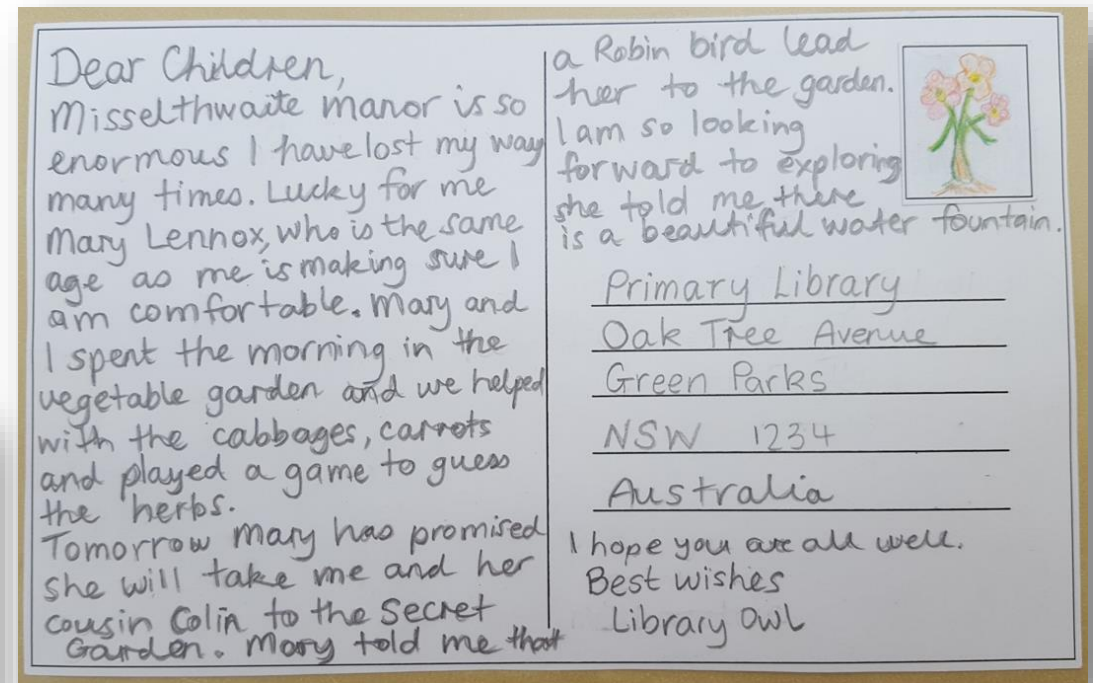


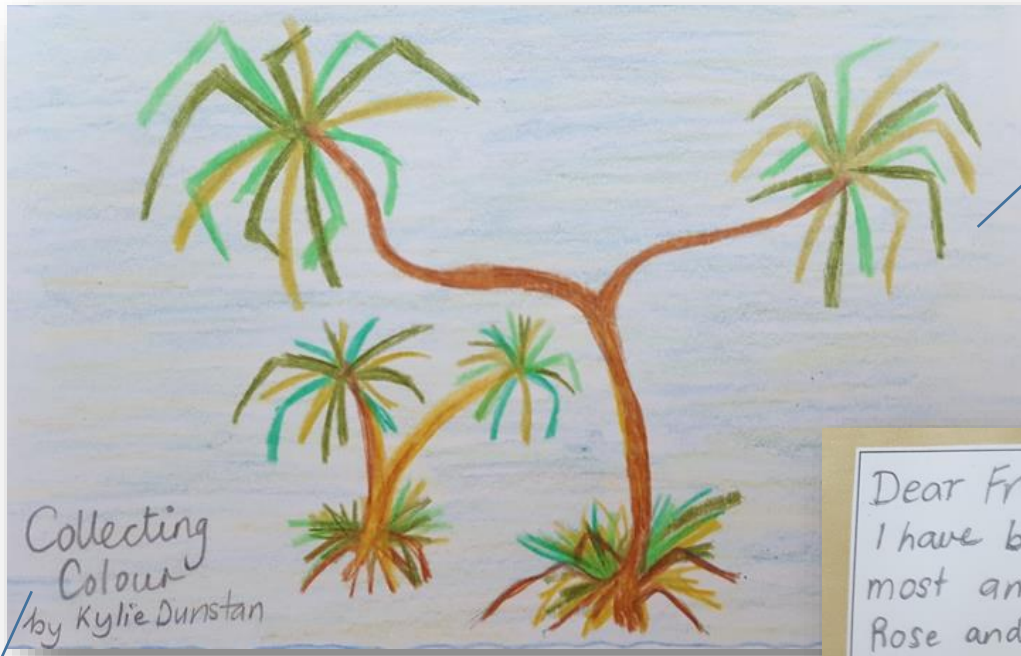
Postcard from your visit reading a book

Draw a picture that matches the book you are writing from, this shows Pandanus trees

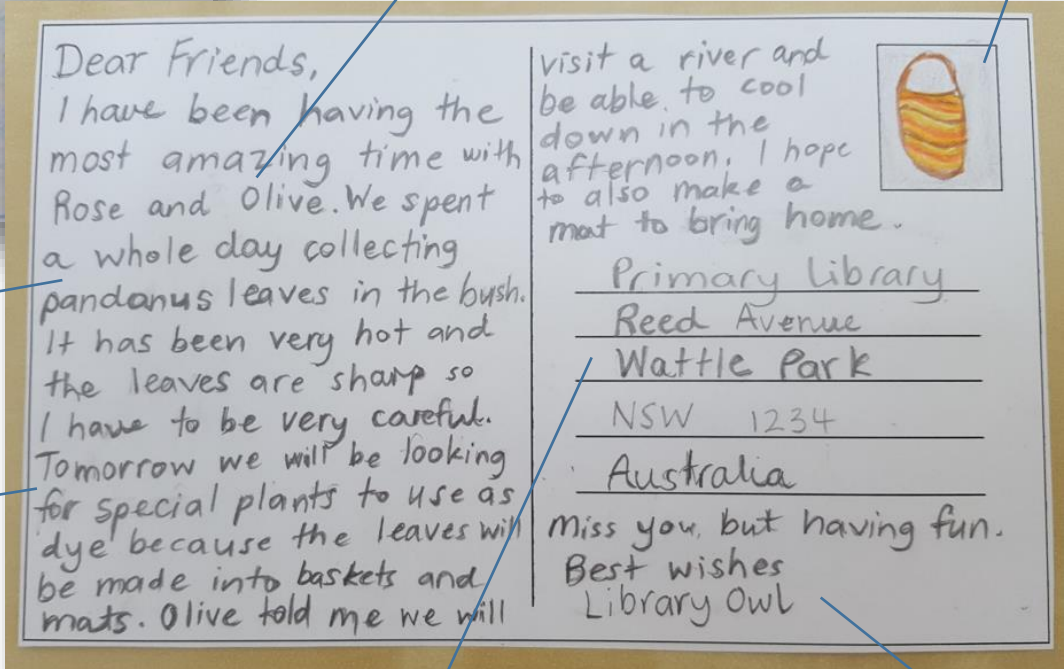
Draw a stamp for your postcard
